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FAQ

Q: Is it normal to have swelling?

A: Yes, swelling is normal, and next morning post injection. Apply ice for 10 minutes at a time if needed.

Q: My lips were really full after i got them done and now they look different, why?

A: The day of the initial injection and a few days following the lips will be swollen on top of filler, which gives the illusion they are bigger. Once swelling goes down then it reveals the true results.

Results

Results can last anywhere from 6-12 months depending on product used.

most injectionrelated tenderness should have resolved and your swelling should have subsided after 3 days (sometimes longer).



Post-Care

To ensure the proper healing environment, be certain to observe the following;

- Avoid significant movement or massage of the treated area. Unless instructed by the provider.
- Sometimes you'll have minor swelling or small lumps these DO tend to even out in just a few days.
- DO ice afterwards! If you ice immediately after the treatment, it will help minimize any bruising. If you ice later on in the day, it will help tremendously with swelling.
- Avoid exercise, or hot environments such as saunas, hot tubs etc. for at least 24 hours.
- DO drink plenty of water after having treatments.
- Avoid hot drinks, spicy foods for 24 hours after injection.
- DO take Tylenol or Advil for discomfort if needed.
- If you have white blanching or extreme pain, or a dark purple colour to the injection site; contact your provider immediately.
