Q: Will the results look natural?

A: your healthcare practitioner will look at your face while it's still (static) and moving (dynamic) to make sure they're able to give you a natural-looking result, whatever emotion you're feeling.

Q: How long will my filler last?

A: It can last anywhere from 3 months up to 24 months depending on product used.

Q: Is tenderness normal?

A: Yes, many experience tenderness to injection site in the first 48 hours. If it becomes more or persists please contact your provider.

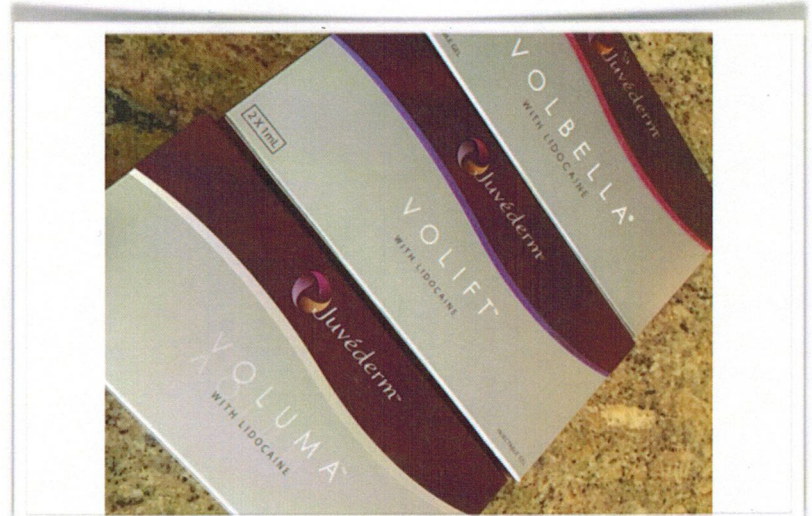
Results

can also be used as "volumizers," plumping and lifting cheeks, chins, jawlines, and temples; filling out thin lips, and plumping sagging hand



Post-Care

To ensure the proper healing environment, be certain to observe the following:

- Avoid significant movement or massage of the treated area. Unless instructed by the provider.
- Avoid strenuous exercise for 24 hours.
- Avoid extensive sun or heat for 72 hours.
- Avoid consuming excess amounts of alcohol or salts to avoid excess swelling.
- If you have swelling you may apply a cool compress for 15 minutes each hour.
- Use Tylenol for discomfort.
- Try to sleep face up and slightly elevated if you experience swelling.
- Take Arnica to help the bruising and swelling, start at least 2 days prior to injections.
